Notes:

- 1. From 1st January 2019 staff numbers are expressed as the number of full-time equivalents.
- 2. LTI = Lost Time Incident (where an employee misses work due to an injury).
- 3. MTC = Medical Treatment Case (Requiring treatment by a medical professional)
- 4. RWC = Restricted Workday Case (where the injured person cannot perform all their normal duties)
- 5. TRCF = Total Recordable Case Frequency (Per 1 Million Person Hours)
 - = (B+C+D)*1,000,000/ Total Exposure Hours (A)
- 6. TRIRF = Total Recordable Incident Rate Frequency (Per 200,000 Person Hours)
 - = (B+C+D)*200,000/ Total Exposure Hours (A)
- 7. HSE observation cards can be submitted by any employee or client. These cards record details of the incident by the observer and also detail immediate actions and management actions. Associated statistics are compiled each month and also annually.
